



EXTENDED FAMILY SCHEME

(Only applicable to Ordinary or Associate Member with Category A membership)

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1.1 Ordinary and Associate members with Category A membership may apply to the Society to register their children below 18 years of age under this Scheme as Extended Family Members.
- 1.2 All Extended Family Members shall cease to be members of the Society upon reaching the age of 18 years old.
- 1.3 Upon registration, such Extended Family Members shall, subject to prevailing Society's rules and regulations, be entitled to enjoy the privileges as are accorded to the members concerned without any voting rights. Such privileges given to Extended Family Members may be withdrawn at any time by the Management Committee and shall be subject to such restrictions as the Management Committee may prescribe.
- 1.4 Upon reaching the age of 18 years, children of Ordinary and Associate members shall have the option of becoming an Ordinary member on payment of the prevailing entrance and annual subscription fees.
- 1.5 A member who has requested the enrolment of any of his or her child under the above provisions shall be responsible for the conduct of and all debts to the Society incurred by such member of his family.
- 1.6 The annual subscription fee per child is \$50.00 and is due and payable on 1st January of each year.
- 1.7 Any Ordinary or Associate member who wishes to register his or her child under this Scheme must complete the Enrolment Form as prescribed by the Management Committee from time to time.
- 1.8 All Enrolment Form must be accompanied with a cheque made payable to "Society of Singapore Golfers".
- 1.9 The Management Committee reserves the right to reject any registration without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- 1.10 This Scheme shall take effect from 1st November 2009.
