# SSG 9-Hole Junior Golf Championship Warren Golf & Country Club Monday, 16 March 2020

# TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

## 1. GENERAL

The SSG 9-hole Junior Golf Competition will be played at Warren Golf & Country Club on Monday, 16 March 2020 in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and with the Local Rules approved by the Tournament Committee.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY

a) Entries are open to all boys and girls with a valid Proficiency Certificate or a WHS Handicap Index issued by a bona fide club that is affiliated to a national golf association and they shall play in accordance to the length/yardages based on the following respective age groups:

Age Group	Gender	Metres (+/-)	No. of Hole
8 and under	Boys/Girls	1300	9
9 to 10	Boys/Girls	2200	9
11 to 12	Boys/Girls	2280	9
13 to 16	Girls	2280	9
13 to 16	Boys	2450	9

- b) The determination in the age group shall be based on the computation of age as at 1 March 2020.
- c) All entries will be subjected to the approval of the Tournament Committee which reserves the right to accept of refuse, or having accepted, subsequently reject any entry without giving reason for its decision.

## 3. TOURNAMENT FORMAT OF PLAY

- a) This is a Stableford competition and points are awarded based on gross score. It will be played over a round of 9 holes.
- b) In the event of insufficient entries in any of the Age Groups, the Tournament Committee reserves the right to combine or cancel any of the Age Groups.

## 4. SIZE OF FIELD

- a) The field will be limited to a maximum of 100 participants.
- b) Entries will be accepted based on first-come-first-served.

## 5. TEEING AREA

a) The teeing area to be played in the following Age Groups are:

9 to 10	Boys/Girls	"SSG Black"
11 to 12	Boys/Girls	Red
13 to 16	Girls	Red
13 to 16	Boys	White

#### 6. ENTRY

a) The entry fee is \$\$95.00 per participant and must be submitted together with the Entry Form to:

- b) The entry fee is inclusive of 9-hole green fee, golf insurance, chaperone fee, buggy and GST.
- c) The Tournament Committee reserves the right to cancel the competition in the event of insufficient entries by the closing date.
- d) By acceptance, the parents or player is deemed to consent to the collection, usage and disclosure of any personal data/information including photograph or video by SSG to relevant business partners, agents, representatives and/or business services for the purpose of sending information on product or services.

#### 7. WITHDRAWAL/CANCELLATION AND REFUND

- a) Any withdrawal or cancellation must be made before 21 February 2020 or otherwise there shall be no refund of entry fee.
- b) For refund, a SGD 30.00 service charge will be chargeable and be deducted from the entry fee made.

## 8. CLOSING DATE

- a) The closing date is Friday, 21 February 2020, at 12.00 pm.
- b) Late entries may be accepted at the sole discretion of the Tournament Committee.

#### 9. DRAW

a) The draw will be made by the Tournament Committee prior to the start of the competition and will be published on its website at <a href="https://www.singaporegolfers.org">www.singaporegolfers.org</a>.

## 10. TIMES OF STARTING (Rule 5.3a)

- a) Players shall start at the time and in the order indicated in the draw. No substitution of players and changes of starting times shall be permitted after the draw has been made.
- b) If a player arrives at his/her starting tee, ready to play, within five minutes after his/her starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is a deduction of two points from the total points scored for the round.
- c) To avoid any unnecessary penalty, all players should report to the starter at least 15 minutes before their stipulated tee-off time.

# 11. SCORING & SUBMISSION OF SCORECARD (Rule 3.3b & Rule 21.1b)

- a) A player who does not hole out under the Rules for any reason gets zero points for the hole.
- b) Players are responsible for marking only the gross number of strokes at each hole.

- c) Players should check their cards in the returning area and ensure that they are correct and signed. Any doubtful points should be settled with the Tournament Committee before returning the scorecard.
- d) A player is deemed to have returned his/her scorecard and no further amendments may be made once he/she has left the returning area or the demarcated area where they exist.

#### 12. USE OF CADDIE PROHIBITED

- a) Rule 10.3a is modified in this way: A play must not have a caddie during the round. Penalty for Breach of Local Rule:
  - The player gets the general penalty for each hole during which he or she is helped by a caddie.
  - If the breach happens or continues between two holes, the player gets the general penalty for the next hole.

#### 13. SUSPENSION OF PLAY FOR DANGEROUS SITUATION (Rule 5.7b)

- a) There is <u>ONLY</u> one type of suspension adopted by the hosting club, which is suspension of play for a dangerous situation.
- b) The signal for suspension of play for a dangerous situation and resumption of play is based on the siren warning system of the hosting club.
- c) All opened practice areas shall be closed during such suspension until the Tournament Committee has declared them open.
- d) Penalty for Breach of Rule 5.7b: Disqualification [see Rule 21.1c(2)].

## 14. PACE OF PLAY POLICY(Rule 5.6b(3))

- a) For the purpose of encouraging and enforcing prompt play, the Tournament Committee has established the pace of play guideline as follows: the total time allowed to complete a round is 2 hours 30 minutes; every player should be ready to play and must not take more than 45 seconds to make a stroke or putt. For breach of this condition, the following penalty shall apply:
- First offence Deduction of one point from the total points scored for the

round;

• Second offence - Deduction of a further two points from the total points

scored for the round;

- For subsequent offence Disqualification.
- b) Players are advised to cease in playing of any hole if the number of strokes they have taken has exceeded the fixed score at each hole (i.e. resulting with no points) and move on to the next hole at soonest possible.
- c) A player has the right to withdraw or terminate from the competition at any time without any refund of entry.

### 15. RESULTS OF CHAMPIONSHIP - COMPETITION CLOSED

When the medallion is presented to the winner, the results of the competition are officially announced and the competition is closed.

#### 16. TOURNAMENT RULES OFFICIALS/REFEREE

The Tournament Rules Officials/Referee's decision on all matters pertaining to the Rules of Golf is final.

## 17. INSURANCE

All players will be covered under the golf insurance policy of the hosting club.

#### 18. PRIZES

a) The following medallions will be awarded to any player based on the respective aggregate points for the round:

Points Attained	Type of Medallion	
10 and above	Gold	
5 to 9	Silver	
1 to 4	Bronze	

#### 19. HAZE MANAGEMENT POLICY

a) In the event of air pollution as a result of haze, the Haze Management Policy or Guideline of the hosting club shall be used.

## 20. ADVISORY ON HEALTH, DRESS CODE, CONDUCT, AND OTHERS

- a) All players must be appropriately attired. Blue jeans, designer jeans, round neck T-shirt and tank tops are prohibited. Golf shirts must be worn and shorts must be no shorter than mid-thigh (no jean shorts). Any players who failed to meet this requirement will not allow to commence their round until they have rectified it.
- b) The Tournament Committee may impose the penalty of disqualification under Rule 1.2a for improper conduct on the course such as throwing the clubs, abusing the course and swearing.
- c) To prevent dehydration, players are strongly advised to bring water bottles/flasks for on course. Refreshments will be provided on the course.
- d) Soft spikes golf shoes are compulsory. Players are required to carry sand bottles.
- e) Only tournament officials and personnel authorized by the Tournament Committee will be allowed on the golf course and within any demarcated areas.

## 21. PRACTICE ROUND & DRIVING RANGE

- a) Official practice rounds will not be organised by the Tournament Committee. Players are advised to arrange their own practice round with the hosting club. For booking, please contact the Golfing Dept at 6586-1245.
- b) The facility at the Driving Range will be available from 6.30 am on 16 March 2020 and players may purchase the range balls from the staff directly.

## 22. PROFICIENCY CERTIFICATE

- a) Students without any proficiency certificate (PC) may contact SSG at least 3 days before the day of competition to arrange a playing ability test at a nominal fee of \$10.00.
- b) Successful students will be issued a PC by SSG that will enable them to participate in the competition.
- c) For arrangement of playing ability test, please contact SSG at <u>admin@singaporegolfers.org</u>.

## 23. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

- a) Singapore Citizens may apply for financial assistance (FA) from SSG. A student is eligible for FA if he or she meets either of the following criteria:
  - i. Gross Household Income not exceeding \$2,500.00 per month; or
  - ii. Per Capita Income not exceeding \$625.00 per month.
- b) Students who wish to apply for FA may request for a copy of the application form from SSG at admin@singaporegolfers.org.

## 24. EMERGENCY

a) Professional paramedic and ambulance will be deployed and on stand-by from 7.00 am to 4.00 pm to attend to any injury or illness during the course of play.

# **25. AMENDMENT TO CONDITIONS**

a) The Tournament Committee reserves the right to amend these conditions without any further notice.
